- **Morning Clinic**

- **Workshops**

Shall be held twice a year. Winner will be sponsored by the Institute to attend the MOACON quiz and will be then sponsored for IOACON quiz to represent the state.

- **Conference / CME's :**

On rotation basis all resident should have presented one paper in state and national level conference before completing the course.

- **Camp duties and Peripheral OPD's:**

Residents shall be deputed for OPD and surgical camps in timely rotation and have to comply by the administration guidelines for the same. You shall be informed regarding the same on timely basis.

- **Preparatory Leave**

Last one month for M.S. Ortho. may be granted as preparatory leave. In case the resident is late or absent for morning teaching program at 7.00 am then these days shall be deducted from the exam leave.
