## **Hostel Rules –**

1. Residents will be allotted rooms on a twin sharing basis. The allotments are subject to review and change at the beginning of every academic year.
2. The Authorities can change the Room of any residents at short notice for logistical reasons and compliance with such change is mandatory
3. Any PG Student wishing to continue after completion of his/her course will have to apply for a room and may be permitted to stay for a limited period. He/she will have to pay the standard charges for the use of the Room.
4. Maintain discipline and peace within premises is mandatory. Playing of loud music and any celebration which causes a disturbance to neighbors is strictly prohibited.
5. Any misbehavior will not be tolerated and the incumbent will be sent out of the hostel without notice.
6. Any chronic illness must be informed before joining the hostel.
7. Room walls and furniture should not be spoiled with nail, stickers and painting etc. Any damage caused will be recovered from the Security Deposit paid by the student.
8. Money and valuable things are at your own risk. The hostel authorities will not be responsible for any loss.
9. Resident will not be allowed to use stove and electrical heater.
10. Electricity switches and taps should be closed before leaving the rooms.
11. Consumption of alcohol, smoking or use of drugs is strictly prohibited in premises. No party or celebration for any reason is permitted in the Hostel
12. Friends and relatives are not allowed to visit the resident quarters and stay in the hostel for any reason whatsoever.
13. A PG Resident will be allowed to keep only one bicycle or scooter/motorcycle for his/her use and the same must be parked in the guest house parking area. The resident is not permitted to bring the vehicle to the hospital and must walk to and fro. No car will be permitted to be kept on campus by any PG during his/her tenure.
