### • Morning Clinic

Every day, attendance for the morning meeting is compulsory. Timing for the morning clinic will be from 7.10 am - 7.50 am. There will be X- ray discussion or case presentation as well as discussion on long questions and short notes.

#### Workshops

Institute regularly conducts workshops in different fields of Orthopaedics. Residents should take active part in these workshops.

#### • Periodic Examinations

There will be periodic examinations conducted once six months. Examination will be compulsory and results will be discussed. Internal assessment results will be calculated and informed to MUHS if required. Unit exit exam will be held at end of each posting.

### • Evening Case Presentation

All residents will have to present a case during the 3.15 pm class. It is the responsibility of the presenter to make sure that patients are comfortable and adequately counseled before bringing them to the meeting room. Prior permission should be taken from the treating consultant. In case you are busy in OT or OPD, you should take permission from your consultant to attend the clinic. If for some reason, you are unable to attend the evening clinic, you should put a message on the resident whatsapp group, mentioning the reason.

#### • **Quiz Competition:**

Shall be held twice a year. Winner will be sponsored by the Institute to attend the MOACON quiz and will be then sponsored for IOACON quiz to represent the state.

#### Conference / CME's

On rotation basis all residents should have presented one paper in state and national level conference and a poster before completing the course.

## • Camp duties and Peripheral OPD's:

Residents shall be deputed for peripheral OPD and surgical camps in rotation. They have to comply by the administration guidelines for the same. They will get a good exposure to examine patients and also learn social skills.

#### Awards & Accolades

Best Resident Awards: Given to  $1^{st}$  /  $2^{nd}$  /  $3^{rd}$  year residents based on their performance in six monthly exam and unit exit exam and overall performance. Also feedback of all consultants will be considered before selecting appropriate candidate.


